KEY EVENTS

Music affair : Music Affair is one of the most promising and rewarding events organized by Golden Shine. Till date, we have organized more than 10 music affair concerts. These concerts have provided income opportunities to more than 50 musicians and singers with disability.

Parwaz-e-ghazal : It is a National Level ghazal singing competition that boosts confidence and gives a national platform to our artists.

Sur Sangram : Which is an annual singing competition, where disable artists across the nation takes part.

Golden Voice : is a national-level singing reality show for the blind.

Our events have been graced by many eminent personalities like Mr. JAVED AKHTAR, Mr. SHAMI NARANG, Mrs. SHAKUNTALAD GAMLIN, and others.

Our artists have captivated listeners with their musical performances, which have been heard at prestigious venues like THE PRESIDENT'S HOUSE, THE ELECTION COMMISSION OF INDIA, INDIA HABITAT CENTER, THE BLIND CRICKET WORLD CUP INAUGURAL, STATE BANK OF INDIA and many more.

We hope to organize many such events and performances in the future, as we believe that the stage is the greatest educator of all. We want to help make the world a little more musical, so we've taken charge of music programs at leading organizations such as the NAB Delhi. These programs allow students to gain valuable training in music.

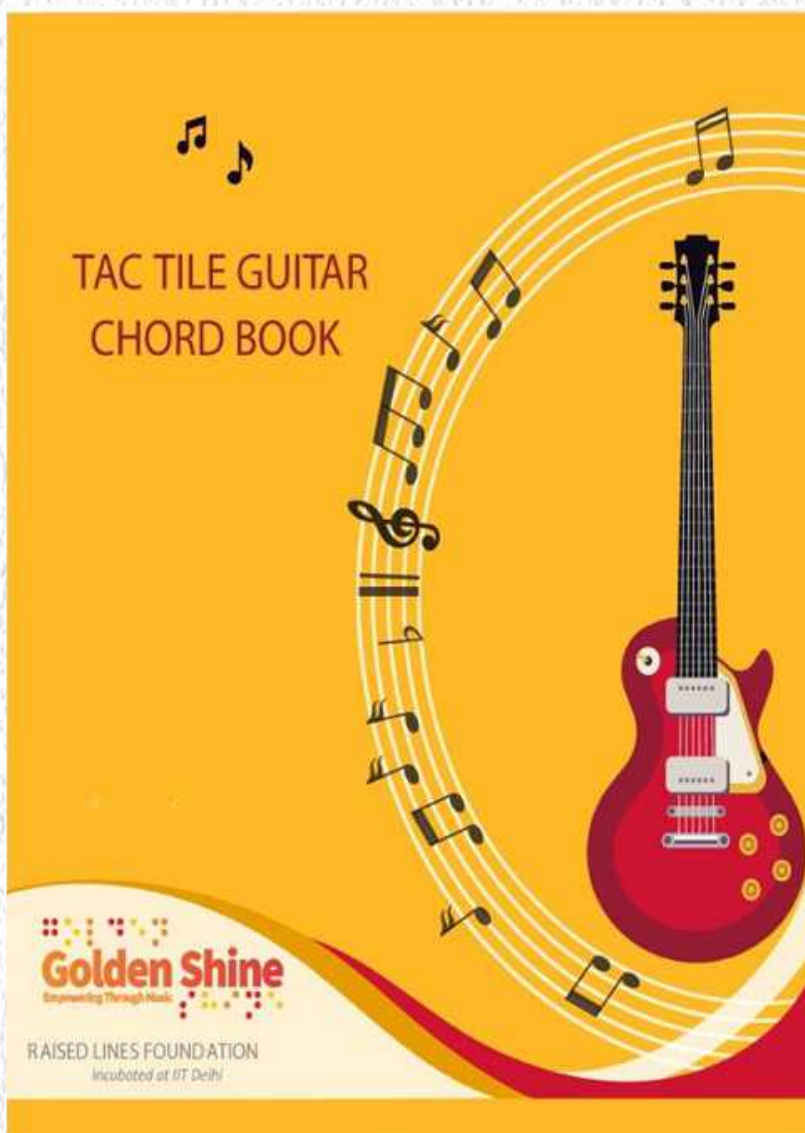
INNOVATIONS OF GOLDEN SHINE

THE TAC TILE GUITAR CHORD BOOK :

We have developed the first-ever accessible guitar chord book for visually impaired persons, called The Tactile Guitar Chord Book. This book allows visually impaired individuals to learn guitar on their own and in the comforts of their homes. This is an amazing feature that has not been accomplished anywhere else in the world before, and we hope to soon come up with a book like this for all the disciplines in music so that where we can't reach, our books can.

THE SWARRIT APP

SWARRIT is our digital innovation for the PWDs. Swarrit is an ios and Android Operated application where you can learn Musical Instruments like Guitar, Tabla and many more through voice commands. It makes Instruments learning for visually impaired Artist Easier and Cheaper helping budding artists to grow.
